**Douglas Arterial Duplication  
Motorway – Douglas Arterial  
Temporary Closures – Lengthy Traffic Delays**

Pile-driving works will be undertaken for the new three-lane bridge across the Ross River, as part of the Douglas Arterial Duplication (DAD) project. For the safety of motorists and workers, the Douglas Arterial will be closed in both directions, for approximately 15 minutes, to allow the pile-driving works to be completed.

Temporary closures will occur for 6 weeks from:

**Monday 19 July to Saturday 28 August**

Monday to Friday, temporary closures between 9.00am and 4.00pm

Saturday, temporary closures between 7.00am and 2.00pm  
weather permitting

These 15 minute closures will occur intermittently throughout the day.

Motorists should expect lengthy delays during the closures and while traffic is being cleared.

Each closure will take place on:

- o the northbound lane of the Douglas Arterial from the Riverside Boulevard overpass to Vickers Bridge, and
- o the southbound lane at the merging of the Ring Road with traffic entering the motorway from Riverway Drive.

For further information, please see the attached map.

Traffic on Riverway Drive will also be affected by the temporary closures. Police will be on site to direct traffic.

Motorists are asked to be alert to the changed traffic conditions and are encouraged to seek an alternative route. Your patience during these works is appreciated.

Motorists are reminded that an 80km/h speed restriction applies for 24 hours a day through the DAD project works.
